

Porsche European Open: Kaymer's premiere

19/04/2016 Martin Kaymer will play in Bad Griesbach this September. The double Major-Tournament winner is the most successful German golf player in the past years.

More than 25,000 visitors came to follow the first Porsche European Open on the Beckenbauer Golf Course at Quellness- und Golfressort Bad Griesbach. No wonder Tournament Director Dominik Senn (4sports & entertainment AG) was pleased with the outcome: "We were very happy how this initial event rolled out, as it is never easy to stage a successful tournament in such a short time." At the same time, Senn announced that the Porsche European Open would be further extended for the second staging from 22-25 September at Golfressort Bad Griesbach.

This mainly refers to the players field, which is to include even more stars — particularly from Germany. Senn: "Last year, we experienced the huge excitement Bernhard Langer triggered and thus we want the German top players to hit their t-shots in Bad Griesbach." And right now, it looks as if this enterprise is going to succeed.
