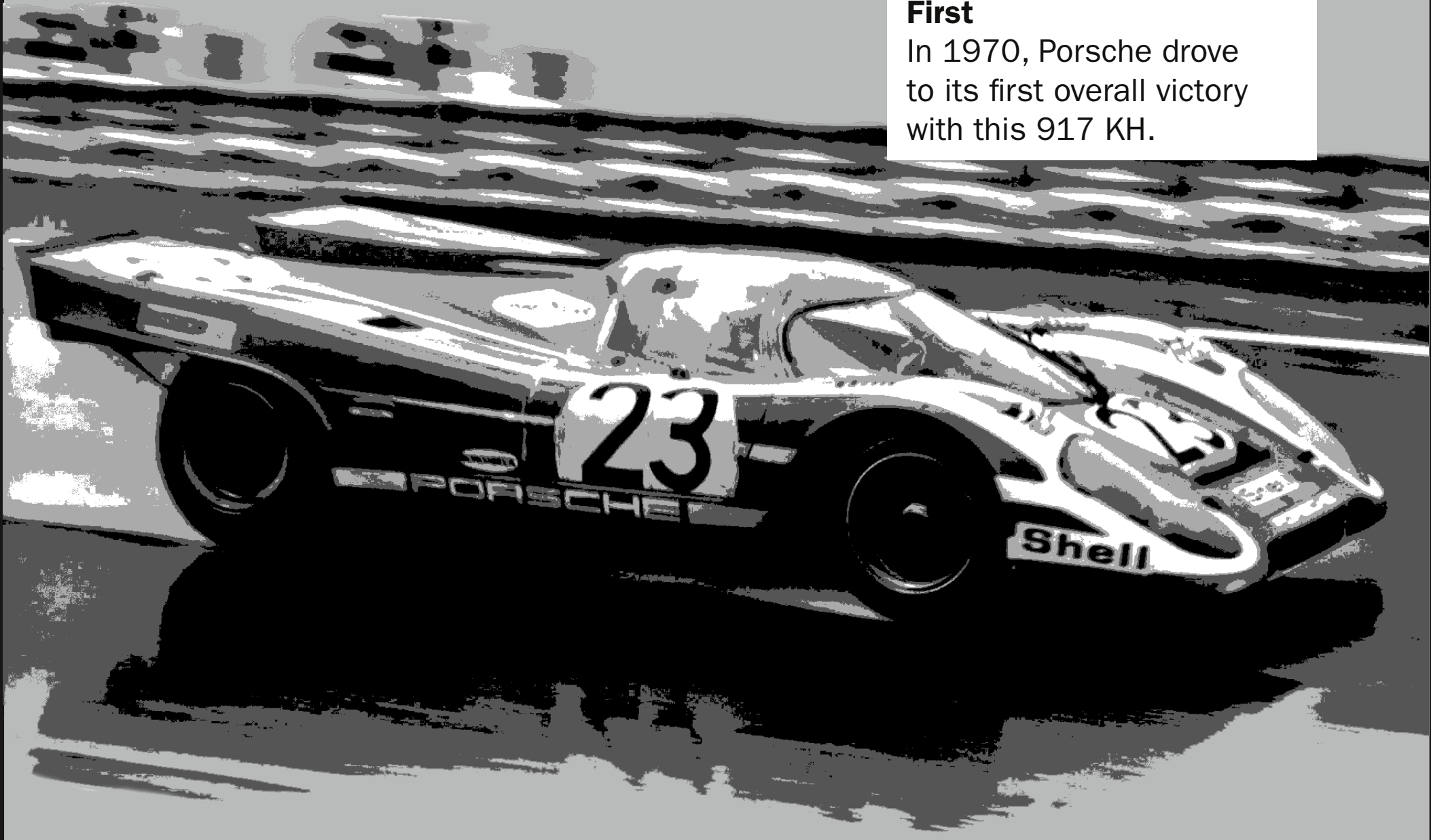

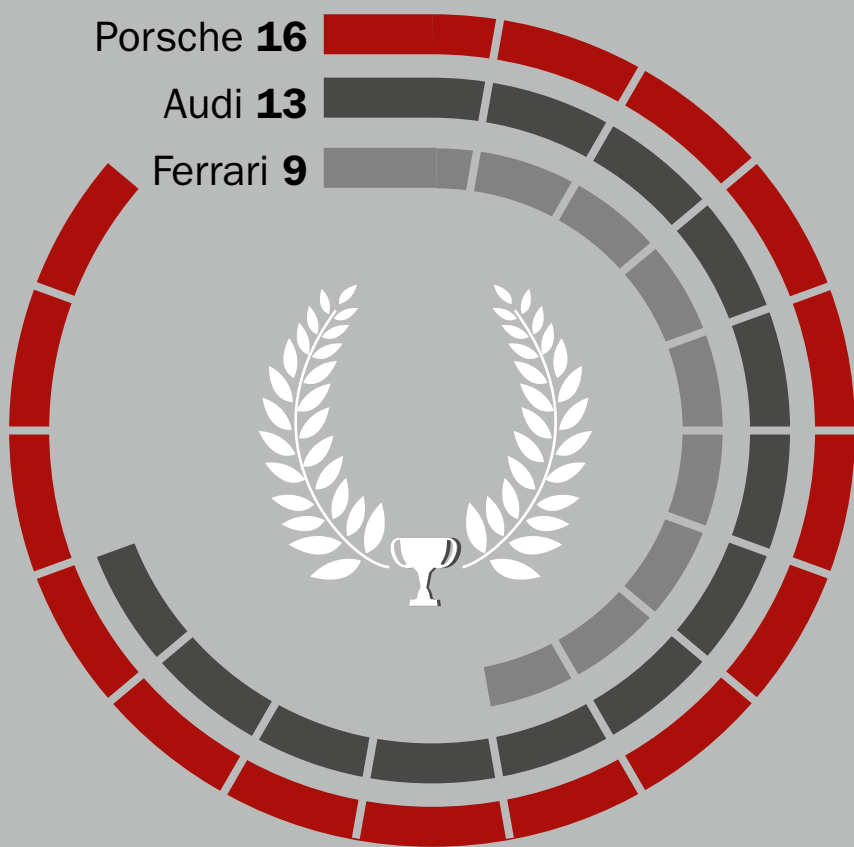
First

In 1970, Porsche drove to its first overall victory with this 917 KH.



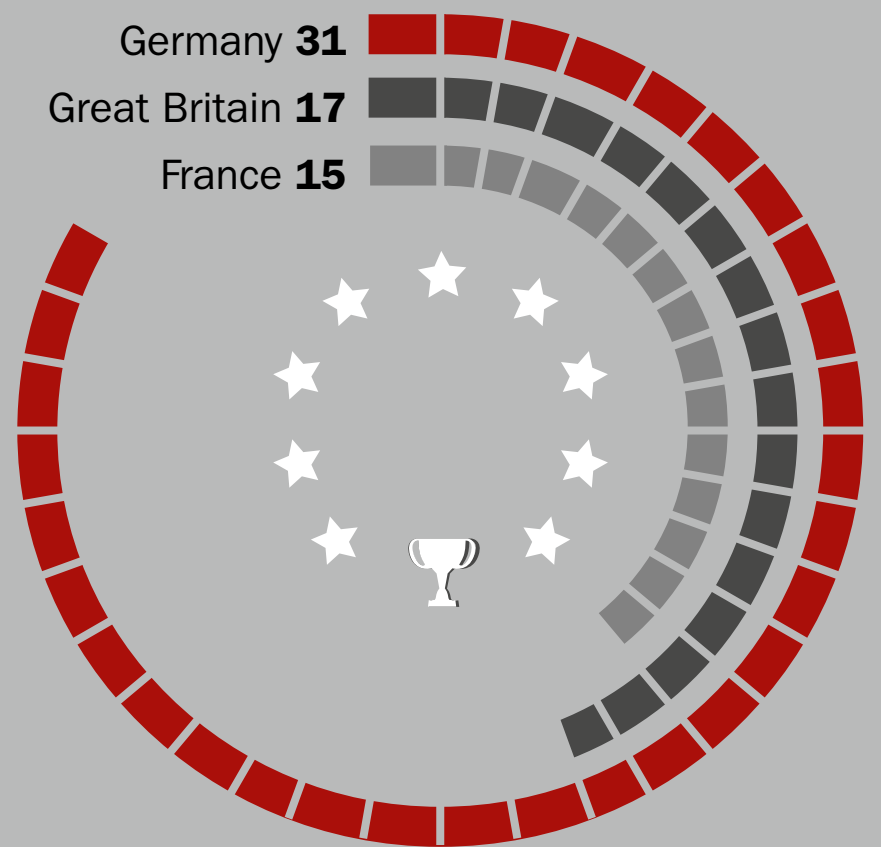
Most overall victories of any manufacturer

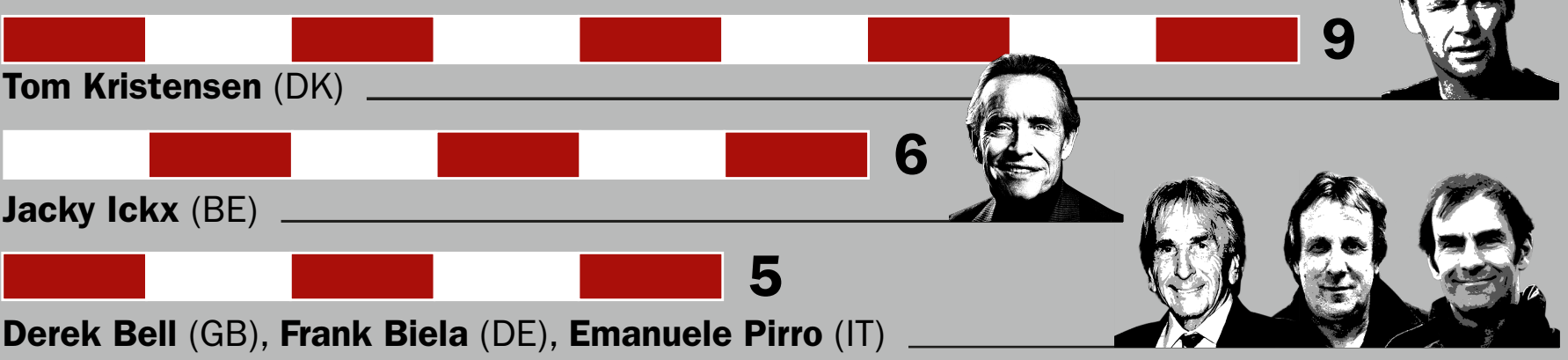


Most overall victories of carmaking nations

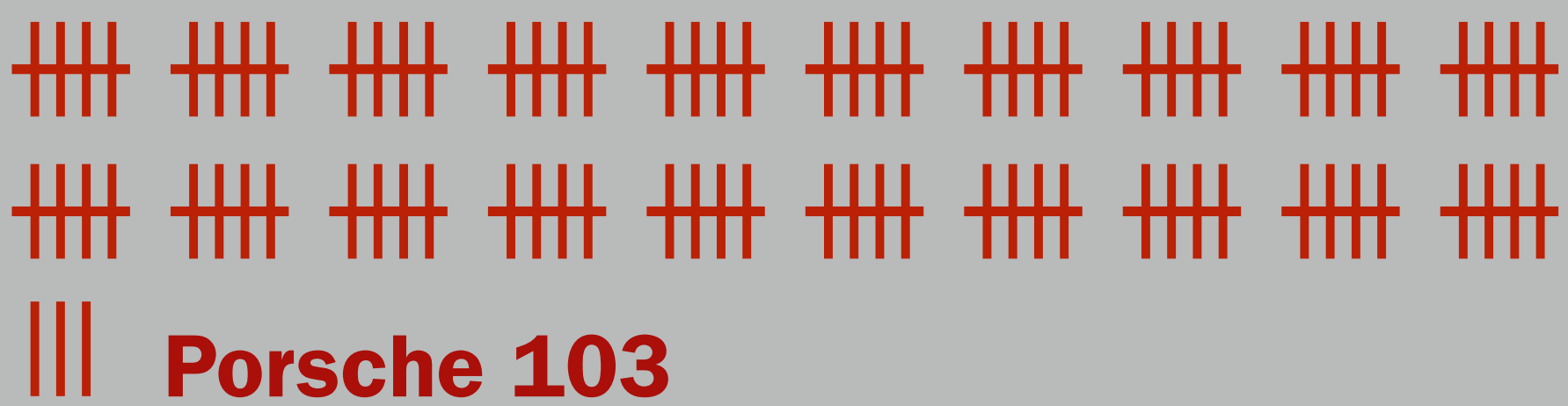
Germany **31**

Most class victories of any manufacturer



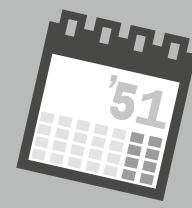
Dominance

64 consecutive years is how long Porsche has been racing at Le Mans – the world's only automaker to reach this figure.



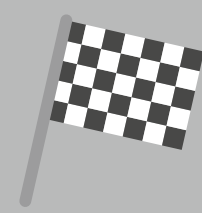
Lights on

822 Porsche race cars have started at Le Mans to date. This too is an unsurpassed figure.



Fastest race lap

3:18:40 is the fastest race lap time at Le Mans. It was set by Jackie Oliver in 1971 in the Porsche 917.



Record for eternity
