Day two was all about "Icons of Porsche", the Middle East's biggest automotive festival which was attended by 28,000 fans. Insights into the latest and rare sports car icons, get-togethers with other Porsche Communities and people with the same interests plus the remarkable milestone of 50 years of the famous Turbo model lines at Porsche thrilled the Porsche Golf Circle guests in an electrifying festival atmosphere.

Particularly enthusiastic were three participants from Spain who took the time to wait for the former World Endurance Champion with Porsche and Brand Ambassador Mark Webber, who then talked at length with the family from the Community. "It was great to meet a real icon like Mark Webber at the Icons of Porsche. He was so friendly, and it was really amazing," said Alvaro Bernad from Spain.

Awaiting the guests the next morning was the world-famous Dubai Creek Golf & Yacht Club, home of the DP World Tour Dubai Invitational at the start of the year. It was also reflected by the excellent scores. Most impressive was Germany's Mumin Saka who shot a sensational par 71 round – an achievement that was extensively celebrated at

the victory ceremony in the evening.
