

Porsche driver line-ups confirmed for 2020 Bathurst 12 Hour

17/01/2020 All five Porsche 911 GT3 R entries in the 2020 Bathurst 12 Hour have now confirmed their driver line-up for this year's Mount Panorama endurance classic.

Porsche factory drivers Matt Campbell and Dirk Werner, as well as the Earl Bamber Motorsport team, will all enter the race aiming to defend their 2019 victory.

The Porsche driver roster includes:

- 3 PRO entries
- 2 PRO-AM entries
- 3 Carrera Cup Australia champions (Campbell and Evans as PRO, S.Grove as PRO-AM)
- 7 Porsche factory drivers (Bamber, Campbell, Dumas, Jaminet, Pilet, Werner, Vanthoor)
- 1 Porsche Young Professional (Preining)
- 1 Porsche Junior (Evans)
- 7 Bathurst 1000 wins (Lowndes)
- 4 Bathurst 12 Hour wins (x2 Lowndes, x1 Campbell, x1 Werner)

"I was barely able to hide my delight when we heard that Craig Lowndes would join Laurens and Earl in our Porsche 911 GT3 R at Bathurst," said Sebastian Golz, 911 GT3 R project manager at Porsche Motorsport.
