Porsche Tennis Grand Prix as a multi-media experience

All those not able to watch the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix live in the Porsche Arena can still watch every rally. Major TV and internet partners will transport the world class tournament to the fans at home.

Every single match in the Porsche Arena will be televised live in Germany. This year's TV and streaming partners include Eurosport, Tennis Channel and Porsche Tennis TV. There are also a variety of digital services whereby tennis fans can sit back at home and be a part of the action, and be actively involved in the broadcasts.

Eurosport begins its live transmissions from the 46th edition of the long-established tournament on Monday, 17 April and will show two singles matches daily to Friday, 21 April. The broadcasts will start at 3.30 pm on Monday, from 5 pm daily Tuesday to Thursday and then from 3.30 pm on Friday. The two singles semifinals will be televised on Saturday, 22 April from 2.00 pm Sunday's final on 23 April will be shown at 1 pm (*all times are local CEST*).

Live programme and interactive “get involved yourself” activities

Porsche Tennis TV will show all the main draw singles matches in the Porsche Arena live daily on the www.porsche-tennis.com website. The schedule:

- Monday 17 April from 3.30 pm, two matches
- Tuesday 18 to Thursday 20 April, five matches daily from 5 pm
- Friday 21 April from mid-day, all four quarterfinals
- Saturday 2. April from 2 pm, both semifinals
- Sunday 23 April at 1 pm, the final

The German commentator will be Elmar Paulke. At times, he will be assisted by a guest commentator like Anke Huber or Markus Günthardt.

The Porsche Tennis TV broadcasts will also include a live programme revolving around the main matches. Awaiting the fans alongside all the latest news is also exciting extra information about everything happening at the tournament with an exclusive look behind the scenes. To be seen are also interviews with a variety of interesting guests and entertaining videos with the tennis stars. Ruth Hofmann will be the roving reporter at the venue. There are also further interactive “get involved yourself” activities” for the community. All the practice sessions on courts 1 and 2 will be televised.

The Tennis Channel will televise all the singles and doubles main draw matches from Centre Court and Court 1. Transmission times are: 17 to 22 April daily from mid-day and on 23 April from 1 pm the final.

Internationally, the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix can be seen in over 100 countries. A detailed schedule of the broadcasting times can be found on the tournament website.
