02/12/2024 Jeff Zwart was born in 1955 and his heart has been beating for Porsche ever since. He is not only a collector and racing driver, but is also an icon of the American Porsche community.

Regardless of the weather, Jeff Zwart takes at least one of his Porsche models out for a drive in the mountains every day. Unless, of course, he happens to be somewhere else in the world – for example, as Creative Director for the *Luftgekühlt* event series. The director, photographer, Porsche collector, and Porsche race car driver is one of the most prominent figures in the Porsche community in the US. In fact, more than 100,000 people follow him on his adventures on Instagram alone. Zwart regards Pikes Peak as his home in motorsport – he has scaled the 4,000-meter mountain 20 times in the International Hill Climb. He shot a short film entitled *Climbkhana: Pikes Peak* with the late race car driver Ken Block, memorializing the mountain race for race cars and motorcycles in the form of a film.

History, motorsport, satisfaction.

A drive in the mountains with our dog and canoe.
