...her preparations and expectations ahead of the Porsche Tennis Grand Prix: "Despite the challenging jetlag which has been exacerbated by our late arrival after the Billie Jean King Cup, I basically feel good and am optimistic. We all do our best to be in shape for the upcoming matches and be well-prepared."

...the Billie Jean King Cup week in Brazil:

"The week with the Porsche Team Germany in Brazil was brilliant. It was a lot of fun and the atmosphere was fantastic all the time. Despite the extremely loud support for our opponents, it was great playing in front of such an enthusiastic crowd. It also increased the intensity and pleasure."
