Alexander Hitzinger, Technical Director, has decided to leave the company on 31 March 2016 to take on a new challenge outside motorsport.

In 2015 the team celebrated a one-two result at the Le Mans 24 Hours, as well as winning the manufacturers' and drivers' World Championship titles. The management trio of Fritz Enzinger (Vice President LMP1), Andreas Seidl (Team Principal) and Alexander Hitzinger (Technical Director) was leading the team from the word go.
